Purpose / Rationale of the Assignment: 2.

The National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) is the apex-level institution for disaster management in India. The Disaster Management Act, 2005 provides for setting up the NDMA along with a host of other institutions at the national, state, and district levels. Chaired by the Prime Minister, the NDMA is mandated to lay down the policies, plans, and guidelines for disaster management, and implement various programmes related to various aspects of disaster management. Since its inception, the NDMA has taken several initiatives and programmes to strengthen disaster preparedness and mitigation, improve disaster response and recovery, and support capacity-

Recovery and Reconstruction

The National Disaster Management Act (2005) defines reconstruction as the construction or restoration of any property after a disaster. The National Policy on Disaster Management (2009) enunciates the approach to recovery and reconstruction. According to this policy, incorporating disaster-resilient features to 'build back better' will be the guiding principle in recovery and reconstruction. The policy prescribes owner-driven reconstruction, ensuring speedy restoration of essential services and reconstruction of social infrastructure, contingency plans for reconstruction in highly disaster-prone areas, livelihood restoration, and linking recovery with safe development.

The 15th Finance Commission has set up a Recovery and Reconstruction funding window within the NDRF and SDRF and has allocated 30 percent of resources for this purpose. As there is a dedicated funding window for this function, both the NDMA and SDMAs need to operationalize this window and establish recovery and reconstruction as a distinct area of their functioning.

At the national level, NDMA has to demonstrate its leadership by establishing systems and developing tools and methodologies for recovery and

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reconstruction. Given the importance assigned to the subject of recovery and reconstruction in the country, NDMA requires the services of an experienced professional as a Lead Consultant for Recovery and Reconstruction.

3. **Duration:** Contract will be initially for a period of three years, based on satisfactory performance, Year to Year continuation is subject to performance review during these three years.

4. Number of Vacancies: One (1)

5. Job Description / Context:

The NRRC Coordinator will lead the coordination of various recovery and reconstruction efforts at NDMA. The Coordinator will assist NDMA in the formulation of recovery and reconstruction framework and guidelines. S/he will assist NDMA in carrying out post-disaster needs assessment and launching recovery and reconstruction projects in states in collaboration with SDMAs, international financial institutions, and others. Working across various interventions of NDMA, the Coordinator will identify opportunities for building a better approach to recovery and reconstruction. While the Coordinator will work primarily on the NDMA's programmes, s/he will also support central government ministries and departments for Post-Disaster Needs Assessment (PDNA) and designing recovery and reconstruction programmes.

6. Tasks / Deliverables:

The NRRC Coordinator will be responsible for the overall coordination and management of the NRRC activities at the central level, including strategic planning, partnership development, and policy guidance.

- Oversee various activities of NRRC, including but not limited to post-disaster needs assessments, recovery and reconstruction planning, capacity building, management of roster, partnerships, collaborations, and database management.
- Overall coordination of the Recovery interventions between the NDMA, NIDM and the SDMA
 - Ensure that respective roles supportive of the NRRC missions are clearly understood by the structures and actors.
 - Conduct regular engagement with the relevant structures to ensure joint understanding of roles and progress of yearly programmes.
 - Provision of a strategic perspective towards actualizing the recovery and reconstruction guidelines at the state level.
 - Based on regular monitoring with the states, NDMA, NIDM, and SDMAs, decide on new additions to the NRRC programmes, such as the inclusion of innovative assessment and recovery planning tools and initiation of changes of action when deemed relevant.

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- Support in strategic collaborations and partnerships.
 - Communicate the strategic perspectives of the NRRC to all actors involved in its functioning.
 - Support in establishing partnerships with various national and international agencies for disaster recovery.
 - Establish dialogues with key international partners involved in the recovery and reconstruction fields to ensure alignment of visions and be up to date on the latest innovations.
- Provision of oversight and guidance to the experts of the NRRC
 - Establishment of the main tasks and overseeing of the work plans of the experts/ consultants/ senior consultants hired for the daily functions of the NRRC.
 - Conduct of regular review and monitoring meetings to guide the experts and ensure their work is going smoothly.
 - Overview of the hiring of temporary consultants that will support the experts, when needed.
- Support in the management of Roster of Consultants
 - Support in the development of a roster of consultants with expertise in recovery interventions.
 - Support in organising training programs in collaboration with other institutions.
- Contact person for the states on the topic of Recovery and reconstruction
 - Establish regular dialogue with each of the states' focal points and act as a convening actor to foster dialogue and the exchange of experiences between them.
 - Develop and maintain a national pool of experts on PDNA.
